The BBC Interview Musk about Twitter

Mr Musk refused to accept there was more hateful content on the platform since he took over. Speaking to the BBC earlier this year, some Twitter insiders have argued that the company is no longer able to protect users from trolling, state-coordinated disinformation and child sexual exploitation, following lay-offs and changes under owner Mr Musk... In order to assess Mr Musk's claims fully you'd need two things which we don't have at present - access to Twitter's data before and after his takeover and, crucially, a clear understanding of how he defines misinformation and hate speech. (1) There is no blanket definition of hate speech under American law, which is generally much more permissive

than other countries because of the first amendment to the US Constitution... "My experience is there is less misinformation rather than more," he told our reporter. Some outside experts disagree. A study from Newsguard which tracks online misinformation - and there are quite a few other studies along the same lines - found that engagement with popular, misinformation-spreading accounts spiked after Mr Musk's takeover. (2) In the week following his acquisition of Twitter, the most popular, untrustworthy accounts (3) enjoyed an almost 60% increase in engagement in the form of likes and retweets, according to the survey. The BBC has also independently analysed more than 1,000 previously-banned accounts that had been let back on Twitter after Mr Musk's takeover, and found that since being reinstated, over a third of them had spread abuse or misinformation. (4) This included false anti-vax claims, misogyny and anti-LGBT rhetoric, and the denial of the 2020 US election result. (5, 6)

1. Misinformation is a narrative contrary to reality.

2.Notice that the BBC laments that Musk doesn't define misinformation, but it doesn't define it either.

3.Presumably "untrustworthy accounts" are those spreading "misinformation," whatever that might be.

4. We still don't know what abuse or misinformation is.

5. But now we do... Misinformation is whatever the BBC says it is, whatever is contrary to the narrative as opposed to whatever is contrary to reality. It's not stated, but it's a reasonable assumption in the context, that misogyny includes "trans-women," so that misogyny includes (is?) transphobia. ["is" because it is real women who are most oppressed by this insanity: fake misogyny is opposing fake women; real misogyny is opposing real women which the partisans of the "trans" movement do – just ask JK Rowling.]

6. At the end of the article, we are comfortingly reassured that that the report was in part authored by the "Reality Check" team. Seriously - you can't make this stuff up!


